

# Nagios Fusion - Resetting The nagiosadmin Password

## Problem Description

You do not know the password for the nagiosadmin account and need to reset it.

## Resetting The Password

Open an SSH or direct console session to your Nagios Fusion host and execute the following command:

```
/usr/local/nagiosfusion/scripts/reset_nagiosadmin_password.php --password=newpassword
```

**Note:** If you would like to use special characters in your password, you should escape them with "\". For example, if you want to set your new password to be "\$new password#", then you can run:

```
/usr/local/nagiosfusion/scripts/reset_nagiosadmin_password.php --password=\$new\ password\#
```
